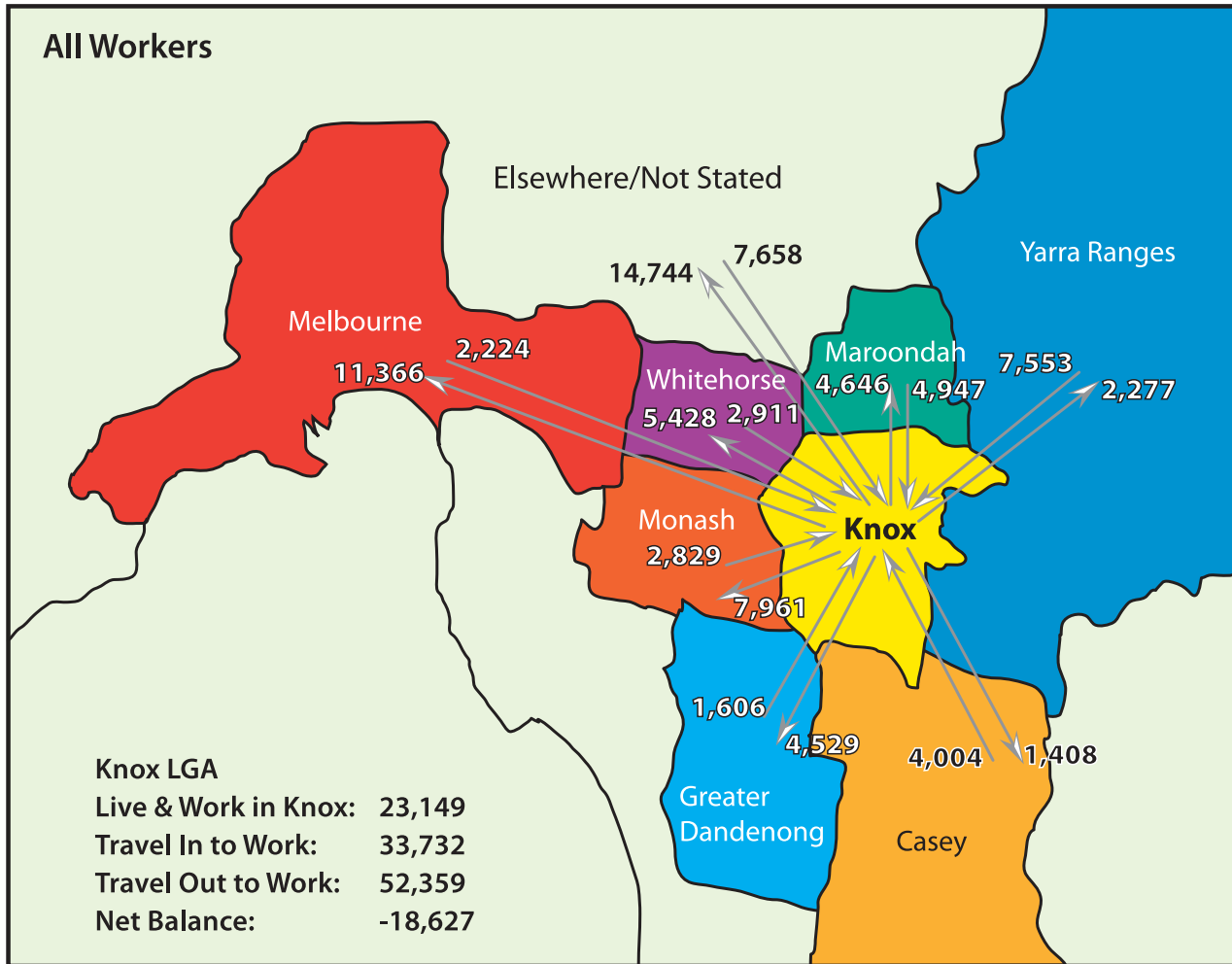


EMPLOYMENT FLOWS

52,000 Knox residents travel out of Knox every day to go to work! According to 2006, Journey to Work data, 52,359 residents travel outside of Knox to work every day. There are only 56,881 jobs in Knox.

In the industrial sector 47% of residents (14,146) travel into the surrounding LGAs of Monash, Dandenong and Maroondah. For professional services, nearly 60% of residents (4,945) travel to Melbourne with an additional 23% travelling to the surrounding LGAs of Monash, Whitehorse and Dandenong.
